The better weather has allowed lots of sports day practices in preparation for next week's 'sports day week', with all the children getting into the sports day spirit. Please remember PE kits and trainers (these should be in school every day!).

This week, two teams of Year 6 boys took part in the annual school games cricket competition at Market Deeping Cricket Club. Most of the pupils had only previously played cricket in school but had shown a real interest. We have lots of local clubs who always welcome new players so please ask if you want pointing in the right direction.

The 'green' team had three matches in the morning, winning two and losing one by 1 point, coming top of their group. The 'blue' team faced two very strong teams in their group matches; in fact they both ended up coming 1st and 2nd overall. The blue team lost to Baston in their first match, but showed real determination and resilience, coming back with passion and teamwork in their next match against Market Deeping - the score was much closer, and all the team came away with a huge confidence boost after making such improvements - they really worked hard as a team. They went on to win their last match against Elsea Park to come 5th overall. The green team played Market Deeping in the semi-final, but they were unable to win against them. They then played Bourne Abbey in the 3rd place match who they had beaten comfortably in the morning; sadly, they lost this match and came 4th overall.
